Overview

Inspire Academy is a California Department of Education certified Nonpublic School (NPS) dedicated to serving students with Individualized Education Programs (IEPs). Our comprehensive programs and services are designed to meet the diverse academic, behavioral, social-emotional, and therapeutic needs of each student through individualized and evidence-based instruction. We partner closely with Desert Mountain SELPA/SBCSS and school districts to offer educational services and ensure every student reaches their full potential.

Programs and Services at Inspire Academy

- Special Education Academic Program: Individualized instruction aligned with state standards to address each student's learning goals and IEP objectives.
- Behavioral Intervention and Support: Credentialed staff provide Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA), Behavior Intervention Plans (BIPs), and positive behavior supports.
- Speech and Language Therapy (SLP): Licensed speech-language pathologists deliver individualized and small-group speech therapy sessions focused on expressive, receptive, and pragmatic communication.
- Occupational Therapy (OT): Credentialed occupational therapists support fine motor skills, sensory integration, and functional daily living skills and even provide parent meetings at school for one-on-one training for support.
- Counseling and Mental Health Services: Licensed clinicians and credentialed counselors provide individual, group, and family counseling to promote social-emotional well-being.
- Functional Life Skills and Transition Program: Focused on independent living, community integration, and job readiness for students ages 14–22.
- Individualized Education Program (IEP) Development and Implementation: Collaboration with district IEP teams to ensure compliance, progress monitoring, and measurable outcomes.

- Small Group Instruction: Structured and differentiated academic instruction in small group settings to maximize engagement and learning.
- 1:1 Aide Support: Individualized paraprofessional support to meet behavioral, academic, or therapeutic needs.
- Social Skills Training: Evidence-based social-emotional learning programs designed to improve peer interaction and conflict resolution.
- Adaptive Physical Education: Tailored physical education programs supporting gross motor skills and health education.
- Parent Collaboration and Support Services: Ongoing communication, IEP participation, and parent workshops to strengthen the home-school connection.
- Transportation Coordination: Collaboration with districts and families to ensure safe and timely transportation.
- Community-Based Instruction (CBI): Real-world learning experiences to promote independence and community awareness.
- Vocational and Career Readiness Program: Job exploration, resume building, and student work-based learning opportunities.
- Strategic Academic Recovery Program: A specialized program for students performing below grade level in reading and math, providing targeted interventions to accelerate academic growth and get students back on track is our goal at Inspire Academy for our students.
- Educational centers: Students finish their work after each lesson at all different times! That's why Inspire Academy has implemented "Educational Centers". When a student is finished with their work they don't just sit there, our students go to "Educational Centers" at the back of the classroom! They continue being engaged until all students finish their work until the next Master Schedule lesson.

- Unique Learning System – Comprehensive, standards-aligned online curriculum for students with significant disabilities.
- Everway Curriculum – Online program supporting students with diverse academic, social-emotional, and life skills needs.
- Inspire Online Curriculum – Virtual academic instruction platform supporting customized learning pathways.
- News-2-You – Weekly online newspaper with symbol-supported text for current events learning.
- SymbolStix – Symbol-based communication and instructional supports integrated into classroom and therapy use.
- L3Skills – Interactive skill-building activities supporting literacy, math, life skills, and social-emotional development.
- Polaris – Online transition planning and tracking platform designed for special education compliance and post-secondary readiness.
- Textbooks grades K-12

Elective and Enrichment Opportunities at Inspire Academy

- Soccer: Encourages teamwork, sportsmanship, and positive participation on our on-site field.
- Football: Promotes leadership, coordination, and pro-social behaviors through team play on our on-site field.
- Music and Art Class: Provides creative outlets for self-expression and collaboration through music and visual arts.
- Community-Based Field Trips: Opportunities for students to practice life skills and social interaction in real-world settings.
- Community Support Services Events/Fairs: Partnerships with local agencies to provide access to mental health and community resources.
- Student Worker-Based Jobs: Hands-on vocational training in areas such as food service, peer mentorship, and campus maintenance.
- School of Residence Events: Collaboration with local districts to ensure students participate in district activities and events as appropriate.
